MEETING NOTES: FEBRUARY 27, 2023

- The AAC asked Mr. Kramer about the progress of the next phase of the school building. While he couldn't share anything concrete yet, he said they're getting closer as they speak with various stakeholders and that he hopes to have additional information to share more widely soon.
- The AAC asked Mr. Kramer about a situation that arose in a music class recently. Mr. Kramer answered that this situation was handled promptly with the parents of the students in that class and followed school procedures with addressing the teach concerned. Parent feedback from that situation was that several contacted the school saying they were pleased with the prompt response and resolution the school reached.
- The AAC asked Mr. Kramer about the attendance policy. He shared the soon-to-be-published attendance policy. The AAC parent members commented on how fair it seemed and how much it had changed from the month before. It appears a lot of parent feedback was taken into account while still balancing the needs of teachers. More information to be published via the Arrow soon. Stay tuned.

*Other items of note:*

- While the next year's calendar has been approved and posted, the AAC continues to recommend that the following year (2024-2025) be finalized and published before the end of 2023 so that parents can plan more proactively. Mr. Kramer commented that he agreed but that this is up to Ascent's board. He recommended parents voice this concern to the board during board meetings so that they prioritize this going forward.
