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A Note From Our Dean of Students



This uniform guide is meant to help parents and students understand the expectations of daily attire at Ascent of Northern Colorado. While there are many campuses of Ascent, the guidelines contained here apply only to the Windsor campus. This document is your best source for information regarding ACANC uniforms and dress code; other resources may be outdated or applicable only to other locations.

What's the point of a uniform or dress code?

- Dress code helps students prepare their minds for the day's work by preparing their bodies daily in attire that shows respect and reverence for the learning that goes on in school.
- When students pass through our doors, they become a part of something larger than themselves.
 - Students at Ascent wear our uniform to show that they are representatives of the school community. They are not customers of the school, but active participants in its work. Wearing the uniform shows that all students are here for the same purpose: to develop their minds and improve their hearts for the purpose of living truly happy lives.
- Dress code presents a daily opportunity for character development.
 - There is nothing inherently moral about khaki or navy skirts, orange or purple socks. Each morning, however, a student has the chance to know what is expected of them in the dress code and can choose to meet that expectation or not. They can practice virtue and comply with the expectations, or practice vice and choose to break expectations. Whether or not a uniform violation is caught, the habit of virtue or vice is already forming. We ask our parents to partner with us in forming young men and women of character by reinforcing the importance of following dress code as a matter of the heart, rather than of comfort or style.

The uniform is far more than just a dress code. In some ways, it is the heart of what we do. To my students: **I urge you to be faithful in the small things** - the details of socks and hair ties and what color pants to wear on Wednesdays - **so that one day you will be faithful in the great things.** The choices we make now determine who we will become.

Everyday Uniform

The Everyday Uniform must be worn on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.




	
<p>Polo Shirt</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Navy or light gray; logo required➤ Long-sleeve or short-sleeve➤ Top button may be left undone➤ White, black, and navy short-sleeve undershirts permitted➤ Shirts are to be tucked in when in the building	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ NO: white polo shirts➤ NO: Long-sleeve undershirts under short-sleeve uniform shirts
	
<p>Pants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Khaki or navy➤ Shorts must reach the knee when standing➤ Look for pant styles with terms: 'chino', 'twill', 'khaki', 'bermuda'➤ Pants must have belt loops in grades 4-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ NO: denim pants, jeans, cargo pants, sweatpants, athletic pants, or tight-fitting pants

<p>Shorts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Khaki or navy ➤ Shorts must reach the knee when standing ➤ Look for short styles with terms: ‘chino’, ‘twill’, ‘khaki’, ‘bermuda’ ➤ Shorts must have belt loops in grades 4-6 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ NO: Denim shorts, cut-offs, athletic shorts, cargo shorts

<p>Below Knee (when standing): Kneecap is partially visible or fully covered. These shorts are in dress code.</p>	<p>At Knee (when standing): The hem of these shorts touches the top of the knee. Kneecap is mostly visible.</p>	<p>Above Knee (when standing): knee cap is fully visible and leg above knee is visible. These shorts are not in dress code.</p>

School Fleece

Sweaters

- Sweaters must be solid navy or gray, either plain woven or cable knit
- Sweaters must be one of the following styles: blazer, cardigan, V-neck pullover sweater, V-neck sweater vest, and school fleece
- Zip-front sweaters are permitted
- School fleece must have the school logo to be worn in the building
- On Formal Days, only navy-colored sweaters/blazers are permitted indoors

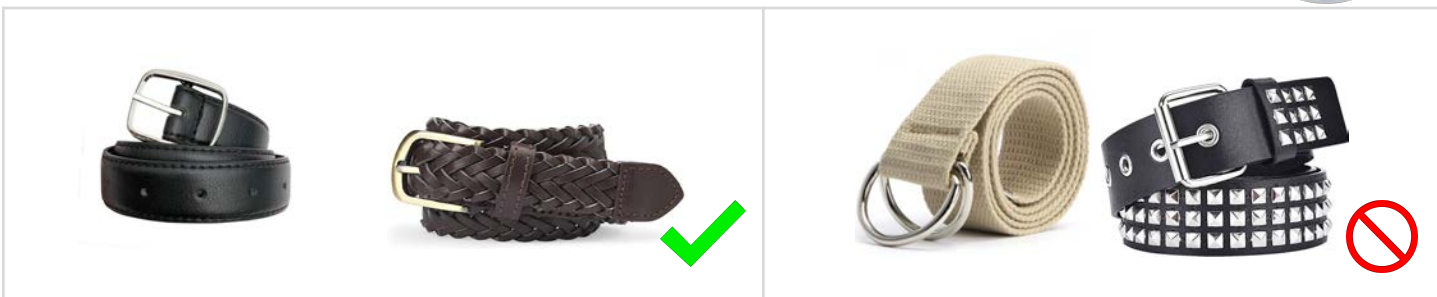


Sweatshirt

- **NO:** Patterns, prints, or multi-colored textures (e.g., 'space dye')
- **NO:** Hooded jackets, coats, and sweatshirts indoors



Accessories



Belts

- Optional for K-3rd, required for 4th through 6th
- Black, brown, navy
- Must be worn when pants are worn
- Look for dress styles: leather (plain or braided)

- **NO:** casual or non-dress belts
- **NO:** accents (e.g., rhinestones or large belt buckle)



Socks





- Single-color in white, black, navy or gray
- Knee-high, crew, ankle, low-cut, and no-show styles are all permitted
- Logos must be discreet

- **NO:** prints or holes in the fabric
- **NO:** multi-color socks
- **NO:** large logos

Hats/Sunglasses

Hats and sunglasses are permitted outdoors for recess, but are not to be worn in the building or classrooms.

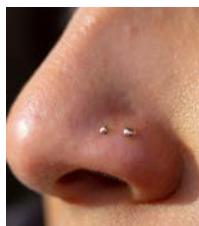
Shoes

	
<p>Athletic Shoes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Athletic shoes should be lace-up or velcro-close styles in solid black, navy, gray, or white <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Laces must be black, gray, navy, or white ○ Logos and accents must be in school colors ○ Search for terms like tennis shoes or sneakers ➤ Socks must be worn with all shoes ➤ Shoes must be closed-toe, closed-heel with a rubber sole 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u>: embellishments or lights ➤ <u>NO</u>: sandals or Crocs ➤ <u>NO</u>: writing, drawing, or coloring on shoes.
	
<p>Dress Shoes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Dress shoes should be solid black, navy, or brown ➤ Permitted styles include Oxfords or dress loafers ➤ Socks must be worn with all shoes ➤ Shoes must be closed-toe, closed-heel with a rubber sole ➤ Dress shoes are encouraged on formal days 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u>: Boots or sandals

Snow Boots

Snow boots may be worn to school on snowy days, but are not to be worn in classrooms or inside the building. Snow boots must be removed once students return to the classroom.

Grooming, Hygiene, and Decorum



Jewelry

- All jewelry must be small, discreet, and undistracting
- Only stud earrings are permitted for safety reasons

- **NO:** Hoop earrings, drop earrings, and dangling earrings of any type
- **NO:** Facial piercings of any type



Hair

- Hair should be tidy and clean
- Hair must be out of the eyes

- **NO:** Extreme or distracting styles
- **NO:** unnatural colors
- **NO:** messy or unkempt hair

Puberty: Special Considerations (3rd Grade and up)

- Students must bathe regularly and launder clothing routinely to avoid offensive odor
- Students should wear deodorant when the time comes

Fragrance

- ACANC is a fragrance-free environment out of consideration for staff and student allergies
- Applied fragrances such as colognes, perfumes, scented lotions and sanitizers, and body sprays are not permitted







Makeup/Cosmetics

- Makeup and cosmetics are not permitted



Formal Uniform

The Formal Uniform must be worn every Wednesday. Students may choose to wear the Formal Uniform any other day of the week. Students may mix Formal Uniform pieces with the Everyday Uniform on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. The school may also require students to wear the Formal Uniform for special occasions, e.g., a field trip or formal presentation.

	
<p>Dress Shirt</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ White, oxford-style shirts; logo optional➤ Long-sleeve or short-sleeve➤ Only white undershirts are permitted on Formal Days➤ Ascent plaid tie is required on Formal Days➤ Shirts are to be tucked in when in the building.	<p>➤ NO: polo shirts on Formal Days</p>
	
<p>Pants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Khaki pants must be worn on Formal Days➤ Look for pant styles with terms: 'chino', 'twill', 'khaki'➤ Pants must have belt loops in grades 4-6 and be worn with a belt	<p>➤ NO: Shorts on Formal Days</p>
	
<p>Sweaters</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ On Formal Days, students wanting to wear sweaters may only wear navy sweaters in the building	<p>➤ NO: gray sweaters on Formal Days</p>
